El Proyecto del Árbol Genealógico

Overview:

Your task is to create a family tree poster, which can be of your own family or a fictional family you design. You will earn a grade for the poster, your written script, and your verbal presentation of your family tree, where you will focus on sharing certain details on three of the family members, all of which is detailed below.

Poster Requirements:

- 1. Create your family tree on construction paper or a standard poster board.
- 2. You may choose to focus on one side of your family or both, but you must include at least 10 family members. You may include pets.
- 3. Include the name, first and last, and relationship to you for each person listed. Please use possessive adjectives to show the relationship to you (my). Por ejemplo: Mi madre Cindy Dreffs. This may be neatly written or typed and pasted to the board. It should be clear who the label is describing.
- 4. Include pictures of each person. These may be hand-drawn, an actual photograph, clip art, cut out from a magazine, etc.
- 5. Be creative in your design. It should be clear to understand, as well as aesthetically pleasing through the use of color, a background image, etc.
- 6. Everything is written correctly and neatly in Spanish, including accents as necessary.
- 7. Please refer to the rubric to see how you can reach optimal success.

Script and Presentation Requirements:

- 1. You will choose three individuals from your family tree to share out on. In your script and presentation you must include the following details about each:
 - a. The person's name
 - b. The person's relationship to you
 - c. The person's age
 - d. At least two adjectives to describe the person
 - e. At least two things that the person likes
- 2. You will receive a grade for the verbal presentation as well as your written script. This may be typed or neatly written by hand. Everything must be spelled correctly, including accents.
- 3. Please refer to the rubrics to see how you can reach optimal success.

Late Work:

Each day your poster is late, you will lose an additional 10% off of your earned score.

Each day your script is late, you will lose an additional 10% off of your earned score.

If you are unprepared to present the script in class, you must reschedule a time to present to Profe before or after school and will earn 50% of your earned score.
